## IMPLEMENTATION METHOD

1. Candidates must achieve a passing grade in both the Continuous Assessment and Final Assessment components of a course.
2. Candidates are required to obtain at least the minimum passing marks for each of the two assessment components. Additionally, the aggregate score derived from both components must not be less than 40% of the total course marks.
3. In circumstances where a candidate secures the minimum overall passing mark but fails to attain the minimum required mark in either assessment component, such candidate shall be deemed to have failed the course and shall be required to re-register and repeat the course in the subsequent academic semester.
4. Candidates who fail a course with a grade of D or above shall nonetheless be awarded the corresponding grade points, and the results shall be recorded and factored into the calculation of the Grade Point Average (GPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) for the relevant academic semester.
