ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROHIBITION ON BRINGING UNAUTHORIZED MATERIAL INTO THE FINAL EXAMINATION HALL

FINAL EXAMINATION FOR SEMESTER II OF THE 2023/2024 SESSION

Students are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** from bringing the following items into the Examination Hall:

- 1. Books, papers, pamphlets, photographs, or any other **DOCUMENTS** or **GOODS EXCEPT** explicitly authorized by the Chief of Invigilators or Invigilators.
- 2. A means of communication device, namely A **MOBILE PHONE**. If mobile phone brought in, it should be powered off and put in the designated area.
- 3. **ELECTRONIC DEVICES** or **GADJET** such as smart watches, ear plugs, tablets, laptops, or electronic dictionaries with memory capacity.
- 4. The University disclaims any responsibility for the loss of documents or valuables stored in the designated area during the examination.
- 5. Should any of the aforementioned prohibited items are brought in, the student may be required to leave the Examination Hall by the Chief of Invigilators or Invigilators if they fail to comply with these instructions.
- 6. Disciplinary action may be taken against students who violate any of the instructions stated in the General Instructions for Examinations in force from time to time.
